Minimum Requirements

- 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Official transcript from your educational institution
- Summer Youth Internship Initiative application
- Resume

Applicants must participate in four mandatory activities

- SYII Orientation
- Community Service Project
- Team Building Activity
- Closing Ceremony

Eligibility

Students between the ages of 16 and 21, and are residents of Miami-Dade County, Commission District 1.

Duration

Exact start and end dates may vary according to the individual business partner. Students begin work within the month of June. The program concludes within the month of August.

Work Schedule

Business Partners agree to employ and pay participants on a temporary basis. Work schedules vary from 20 to 40-hours per-week, up to 10 weeks.
